

## **PROPOSED ACTIVITIES FOR THE NATIONAL CLEAN-UP MONTH & THE OZONE MONTH CELEBRATIONS**

1. Clean-up of coastal areas, canals, creeks and/or esteros in cooperation with concerned LGUs, Barangay officials and residents;
2. Lecture-forum on salient provisions of Clean Air Act and the Clean Water Act;
3. Bantay-Sunog Basura campaign;
4. Bantay Tambutso sa Malls campaign;
5. Bawas Balot, Bawas Basura campaign;
6. Holding of Roving Exhibits in school campuses, municipal and city halls showcasing best practices and technologies in ecological solid waste management;
7. Campaign for Motor Vehicle Preventive Maintenance for drivers and operators;
8. Holding of ozone quiz competitions;
9. Lecture and film showing on the Science of Ozone and Moving Forward to an ODS-Free Philippines;
10. Lecture-Forum on Understanding Climate Change and the Philippine Commitment under the Kyoto Protocol;
11. Holding of symposia on various environment-related laws;
12. Holding of Enviro Quiz Competition within school campuses;
13. Turning off of vehicle engines when parked;
14. Staging of contests for the Cleanest and Most Organized School classrooms
15. Holding of the on-the-spot poster making, jingle, essay, slogan, logo or sticker-design contests;

16. Encouragement of active participation of students in various water and air-related campaigns;
17. Posting of clean-up campaign slogans inside school campuses, market stalls, municipal and city hall premises;
18. Community Clean-up and Beautification Drive
19. Planting and growing medicinal and herbal plants;
20. Briefing-Orientation with focus on the “Greenhouse Effects” and “Global Warming”;
