Background

- During the NAC meeting last December 12, 2012, it was discussed that a clear cut policy on national economic framework for the CCT beneficiaries is needed. To prevent the strategy from becoming off-tangent to the needs of the beneficiaries, it is important to categorize the beneficiaries to the sectors they belong to.
- NAPC called for having one set of data where we can monitor the results.

Objective

- Disaggregated data on the Set 1 and Set 2 beneficiaries of Pantawid Pamilya Program into sectoral and geographical categories would serve as:
 - a. Baseline for planning transition strategies for graduating beneficiaries of the program.
 - b. Basis for convergence efforts of line agencies, specifically the members of the National Advisory Committee.

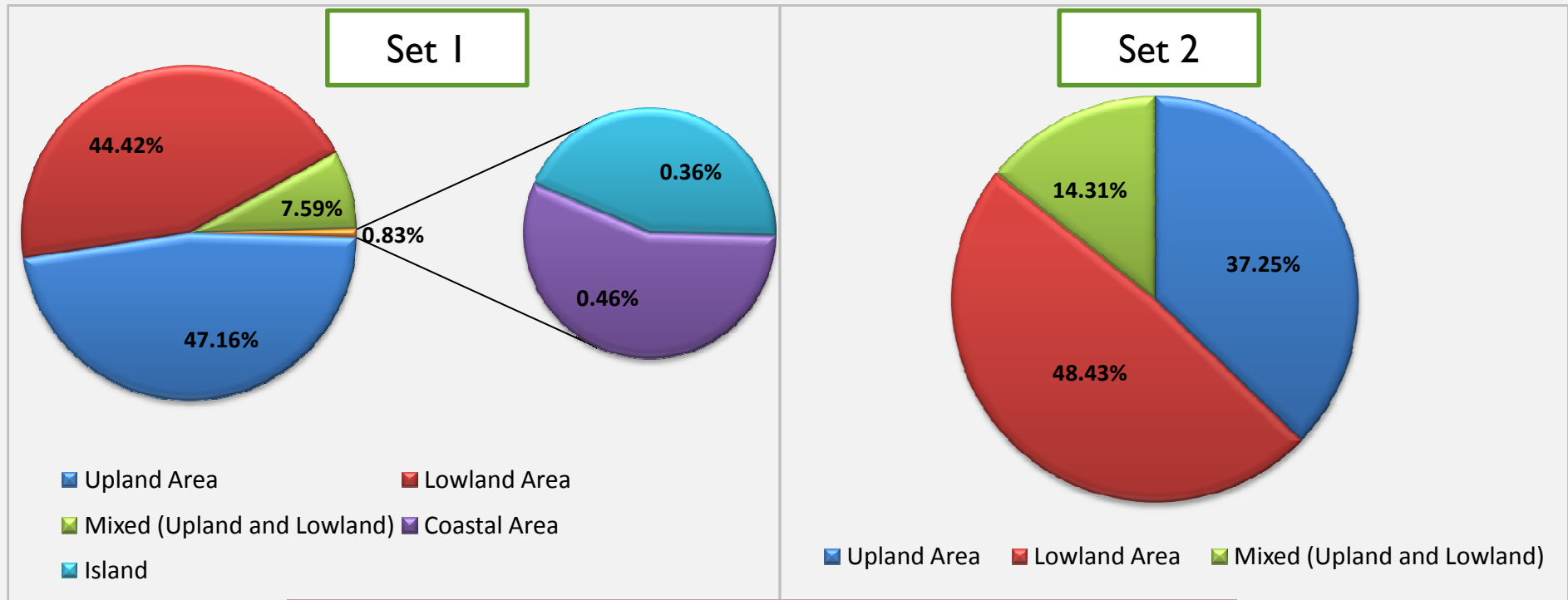

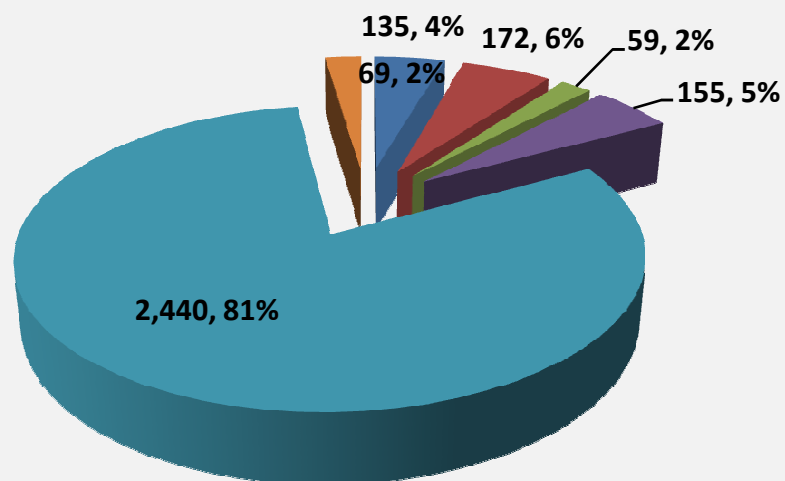

Profile of Set 1 and 2 Areas (Barangay Level)

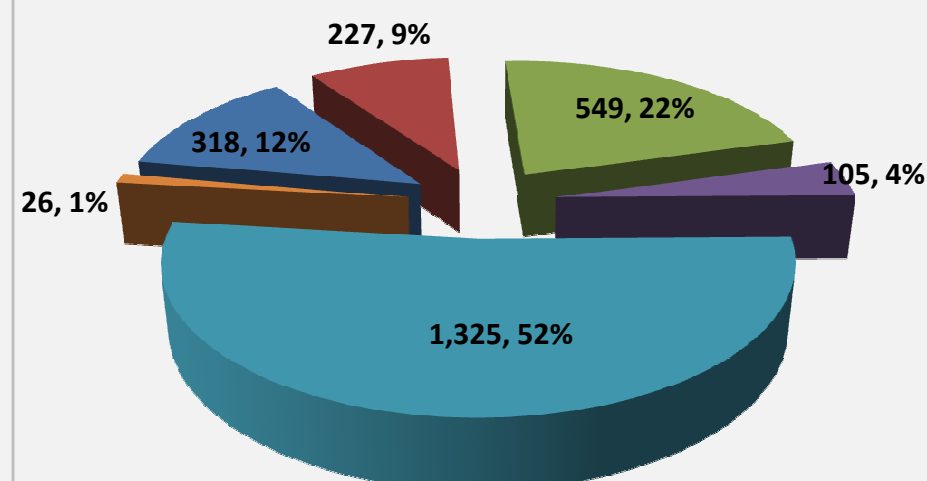

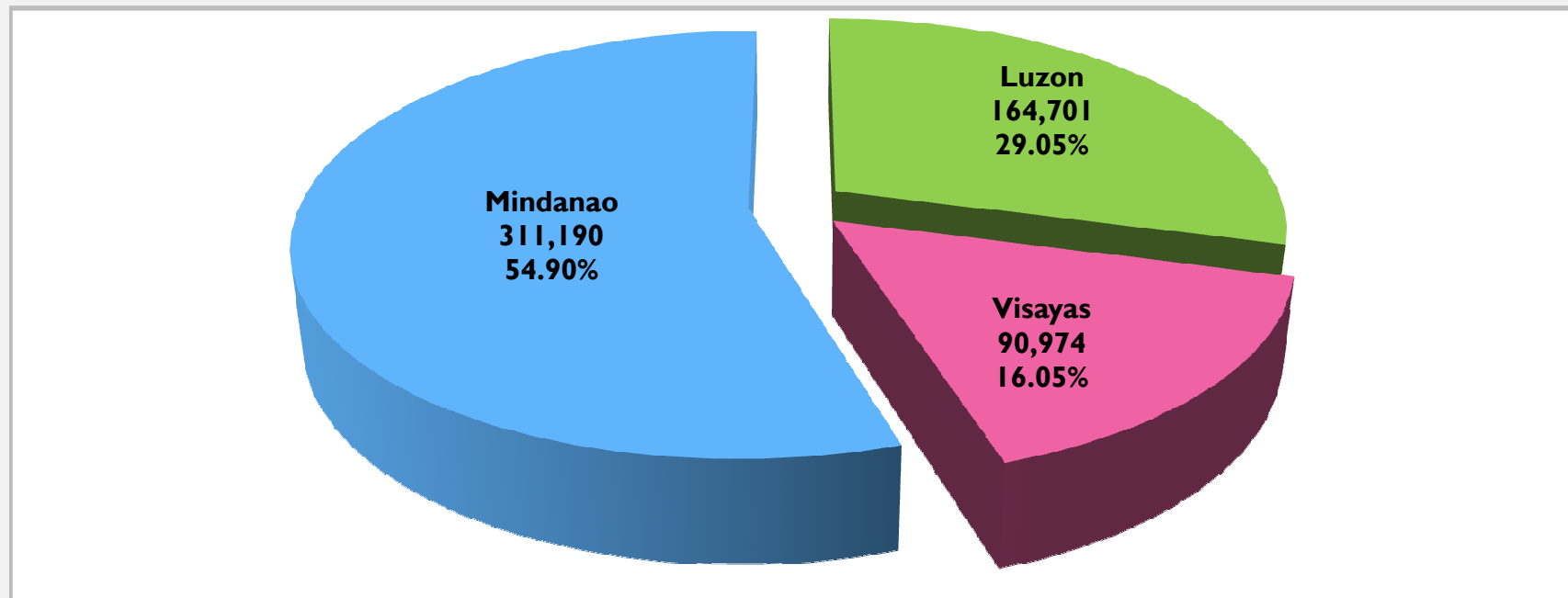
