

**CEAP-NBEC Visayas-Mindanao Seminar on Key Features of the K to 12 Program
(MTB-MLE, Spiral Progression Approach and Standards-based Assessment)**

11-13 July 2013, University of San Jose-Recoletos, Cebu City.

Rationale

In the light of the implementation of the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum, school leaders and teachers have expressed the need to be provided with further clarification on three important features of the curriculum. These are: the Mother-Tongue Based Multilingual Education (MTB-MLE) framework, the Spiral Progression Approach in Mathematics and Science, and Standards-Based Assessment.

With the assistance of experts in the disciplines and representatives of the Department of Education, this three-day seminar-workshop aims to assist schools further in continuously meeting the demands of the new curriculum.

Objectives

At the end of the seminar-workshop, participants will be able to:

1. Acquire the fundamental principles of managing MTB-MLE in their respective school contexts;
2. Understand the underlying principles and nuances of the Spiral Progression model in the teaching of Mathematics and Science; and
3. Attain a more holistic and functional view of the demands of the K to 12 Assessment Framework.

Design of the Seminar-Workshop

Plenary sessions on the three identified features of the K to 12 Program shall be managed by specialists from the Department of Education (DepEd), UP National Institute for Science and Mathematics Education (UP-NISMED) and the Philippine Association for Language Teaching, Inc. (PALT). These sessions shall provide a comprehensive discussion of the theoretical and pedagogical framework while the workshops will walk participants through a detailed analysis of the strategies, materials, and other expectations in implementing MTB-MLE. Emphasis shall be given on how schools may respond to the challenges of implementing the three identified features without losing sight of their respective vision, mission, and goals.
